Do you minister to youth in your church? Are you a parent or caregiver of a teen? If so, you're invited to our next Youth Mental Health First Aid course!

Just like CPR training, Mental Health First Aid prepares you to recognize the signs and symptoms of distress and connect a youth with the help they need. Mental Health First Aid trainings empowers adults who engage with adolescents to respond compassionately and directly when a youth experiences a mental health challenge or crisis.

Whether a youth is experiencing a mental health struggle or spiritual crisis, the tools learned in this training, including what signs to look for and how to offer direct and compassionate help, will be an asset to anyone who is supporting the emotional and spiritual development of youth.
